Airnorth's selection of fuel efficient Embraer jet aircraft was another strategic decision designed to keep costs and emissions to a minimum. Airnorth is currently operating three Jets throughout the network with a fourth due to come online in early 2013.

"We have always focused on delivering the highest standard of services to our customers, in particular from Timor-Leste, where we have been operating for over 10 years and currently provide the only Jet service from Darwin," said Ms Saunders.

"We also contribute this success to the high calibre of staff we have here at Airnorth. It is their hard work and commitment that's helped to get the company where it is today," she said.

The Chief Minister's Awards recognise the important contribution that NT businesses make to the local economy through job creation and increased prosperity in the community. As the NT winner Airnorth will now be entered into the Prime Minister's Exporter of the Year Awards in Brisbane in December.
