

FIREARM AND OTHER ADVENTURE RELATED SPORTING EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST AND DECLARATION

In order for Airnorth to accept your item(s), the following criteria must be met:

- Passengers checking in a firearm or ammunition must be able to show a valid firearm licence, permit or law enforcement agency identification
- Rifles must be unloaded and the bolt must be removed and packed separately from the firearm
- Hand guns must be unloaded and locked in a hard sided container
- Ammunition must be packed separately and in the original manufacturers packing (or better) so
 as to protect against shock, secured against movement and unable to trigger accidentally under
 conditions of manual handling. Separate packages can be enclosed in one suitcase. For example,
 one hand gun and one box of ammunition
- · Ammunition must not exceed 5 kilograms in weight
- There must be no indication on the suitcase to identify the contents
- Luggage must be locked with a combination lock or key mechanism
- All firearms, ammunition and firearm parts, including firearm frames, receivers, clips and magazines are prohibited in carry-on baggage
- Archery sets and spear guns must be unloaded. Arrows/spears packed separately can be enclosed in one package
- Spears, javelins or a like must have the sharp protruding implements covered so as to not come into contact with other baggage or cause harm to employees
- Firearms and adventure sporting equipment will be labelled "DELIVER TO BAGGAGE SERVICES."
 On arrival please collect your item from the airport staff upon presentation of your identification and baggage stubs.
